




# Unemployment by Gender






# Job Trends

San Francisco-Oakland-Berkeley, CA had a March 2022 unemployment rate of 2.91%, decreasing from 3.36% 5 years before.














# **Top Industry Location Quotient**






# **Top Industry GRP**






### **Top Occupation Location Quotient**






### **Top Occupation Earnings**



Median Hourly Earnings




