- Concerning educational attainment, **23.4% of Indianapolis-Carmel-Anderson**, **IN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.1% above the national average), and **8.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.7% below the national average).






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity












Veterans










Top Industry GRP








