- From 2016 to 2021, jobs declined by 2.3% in Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim, CA from 6,887,751 to 6,732,047. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 0.7% by 3.0%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 62.0% to 62.0% between 2016 and 2021.
- Concerning educational attainment, 22.8% of Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim, CA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (2.5% above the national average), and 7.2% hold an Associate's Degree (1.5% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2021 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Individual and Family Services.

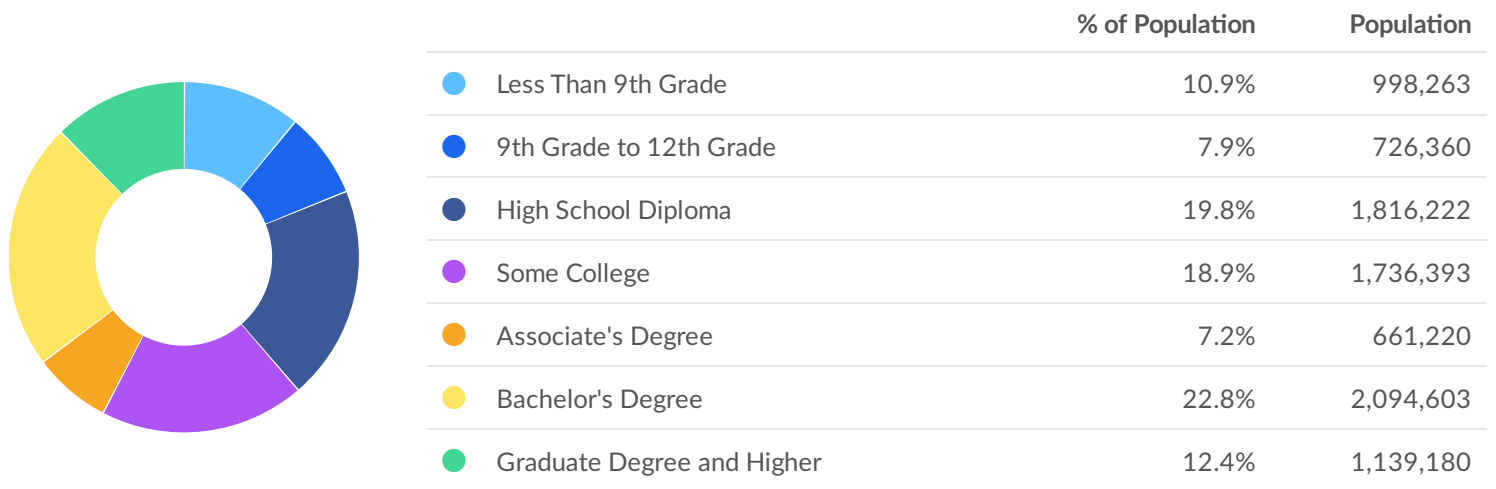

## Dec 2021 Labor Force Breakdown



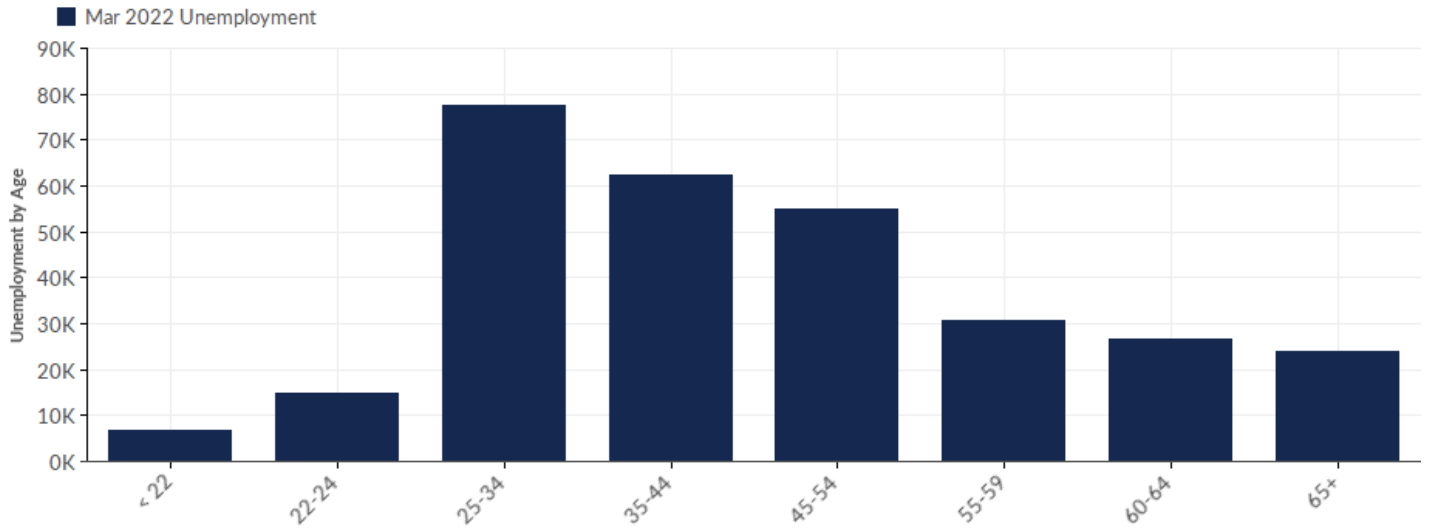
## Educational Attainment

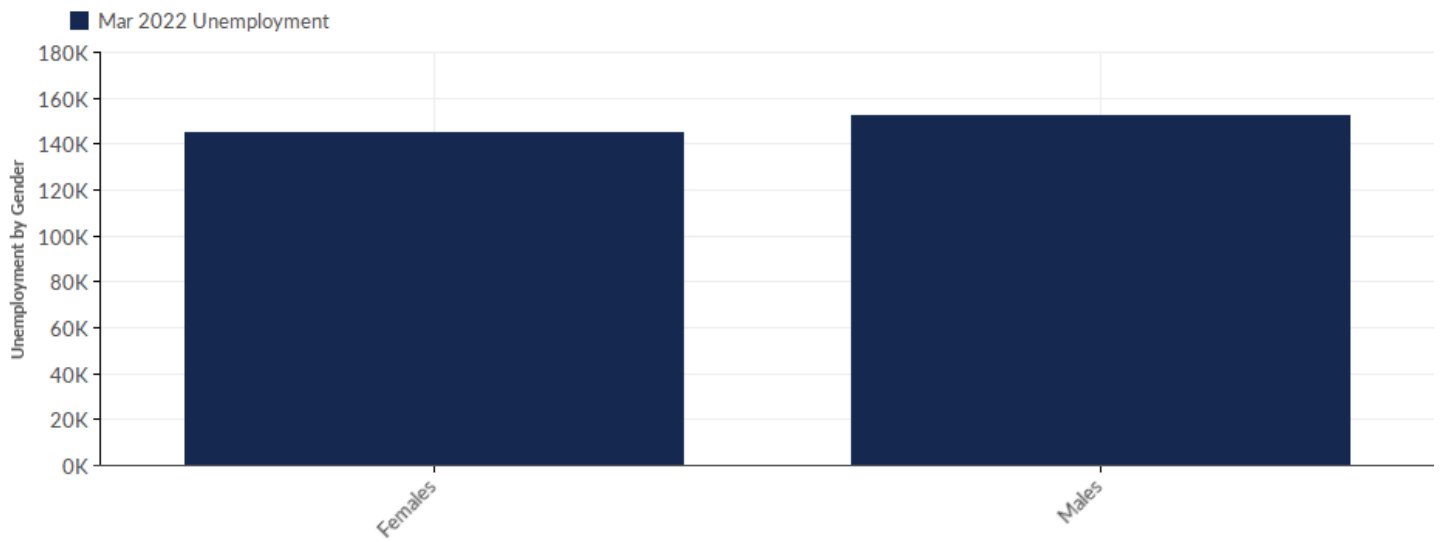

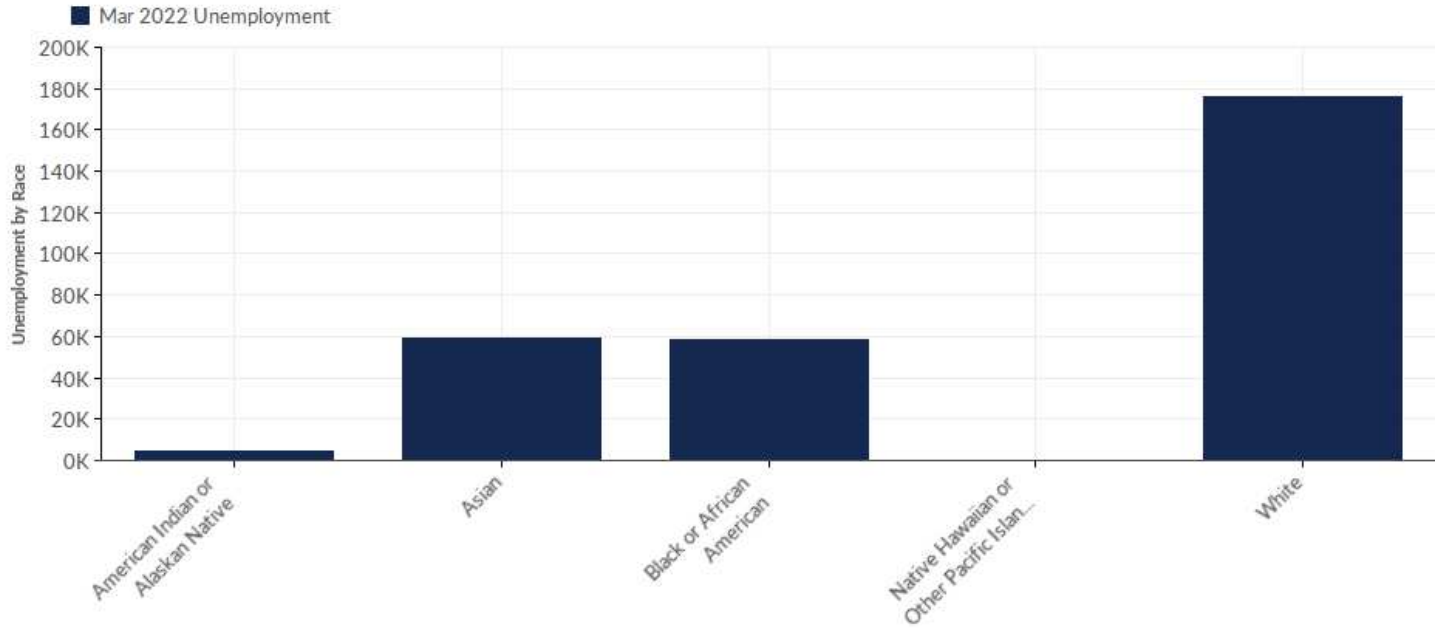

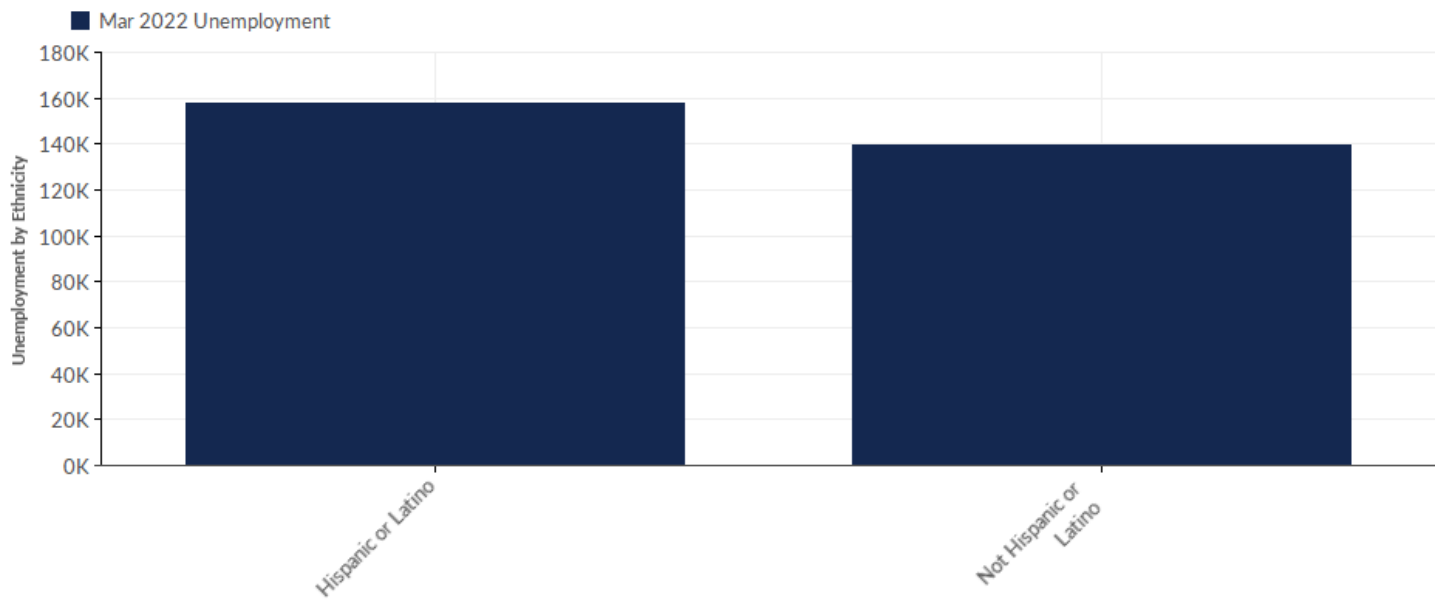

## Unemployment by Ethnicity

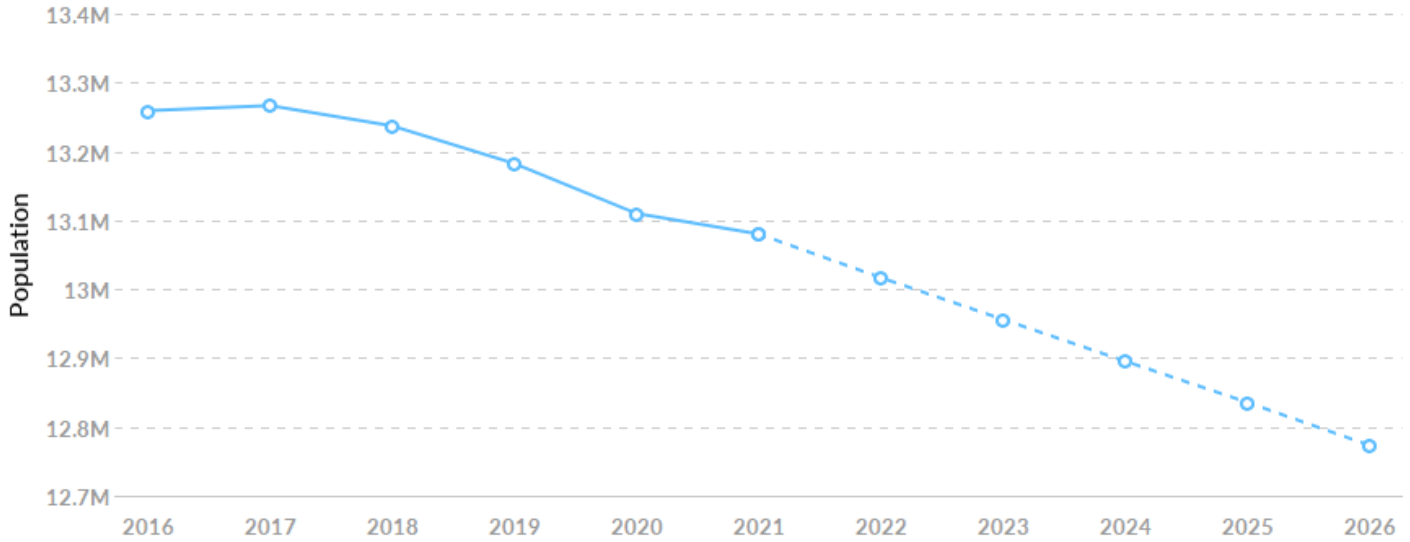

## Population Trends

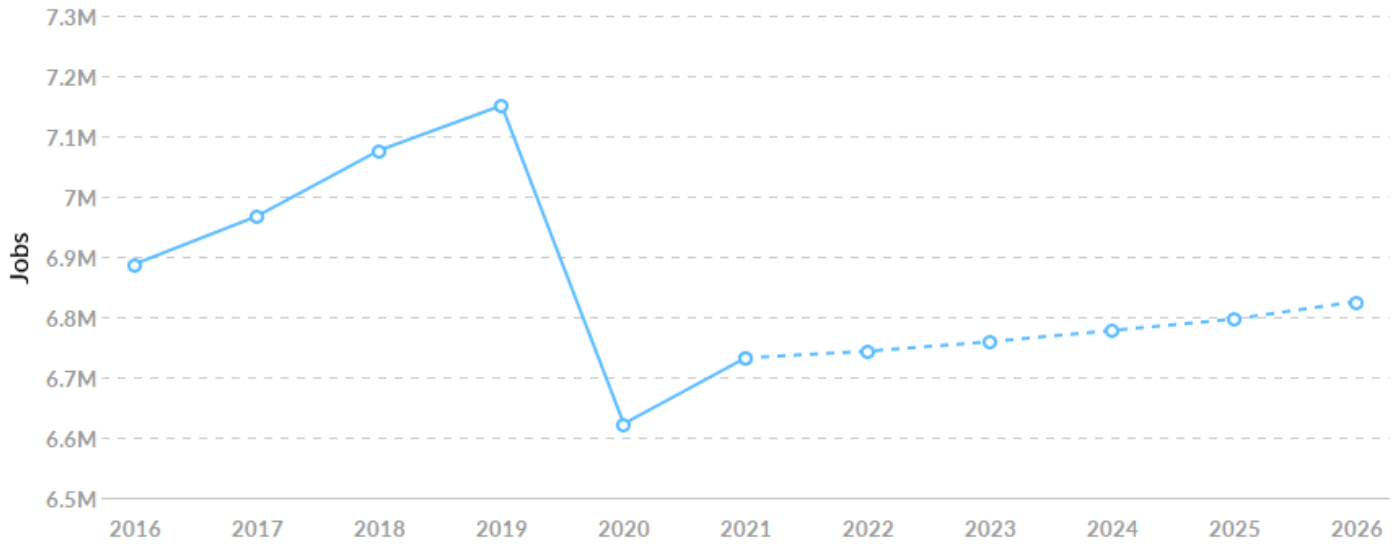

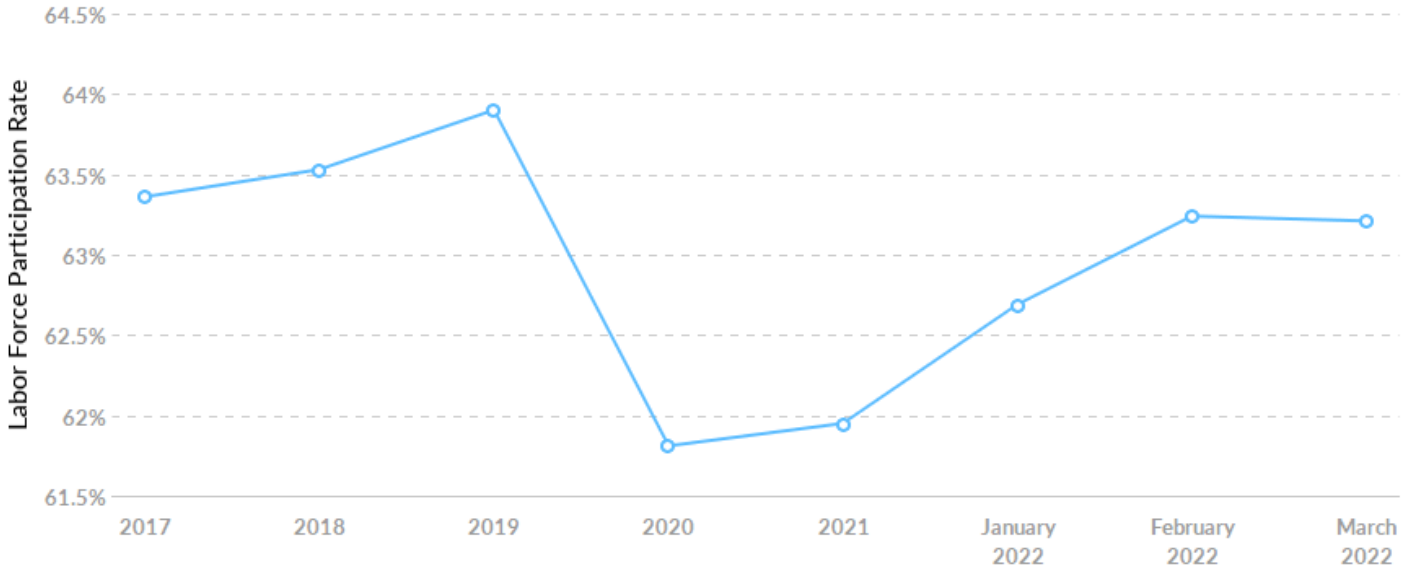
## Job Trends

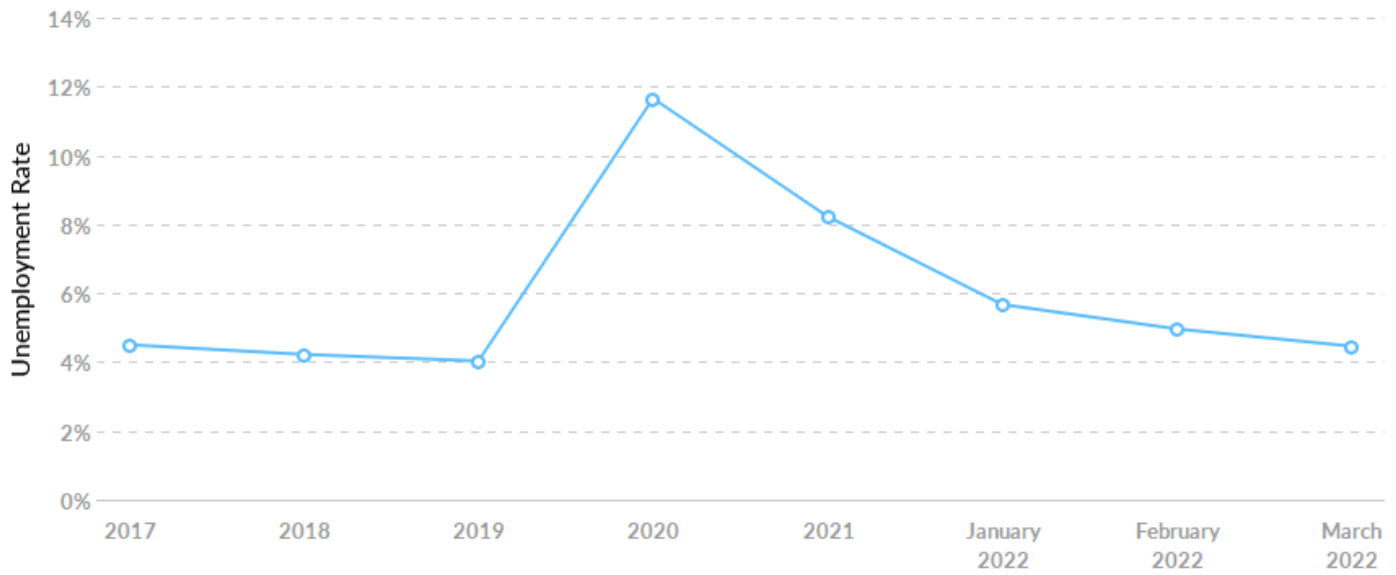

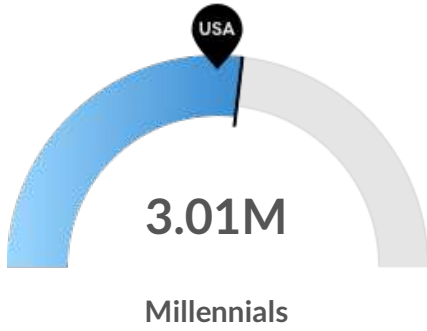
## Unemployment Rate Trends

Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim, CA had a March 2022 unemployment rate of 4.46%, **decreasing from 4.50%** 5 years before.

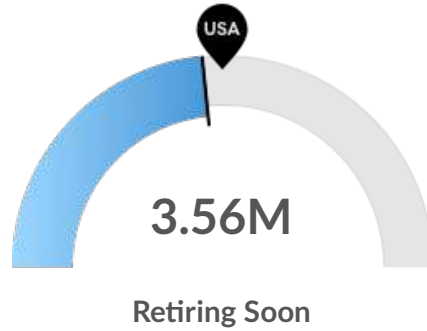

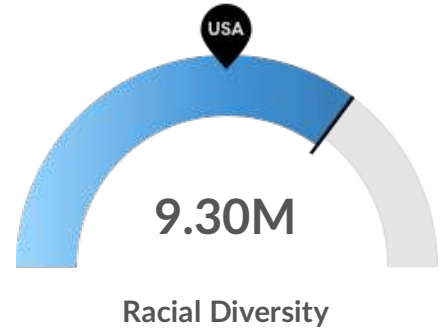
## Population Characteristics



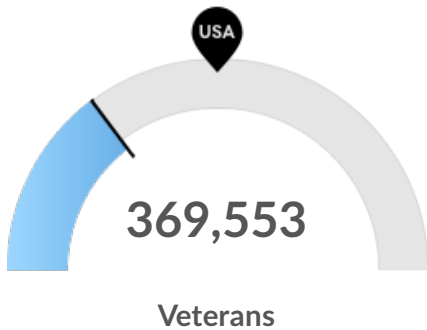
Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim, CA has 3,006,550 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 2,701,604.

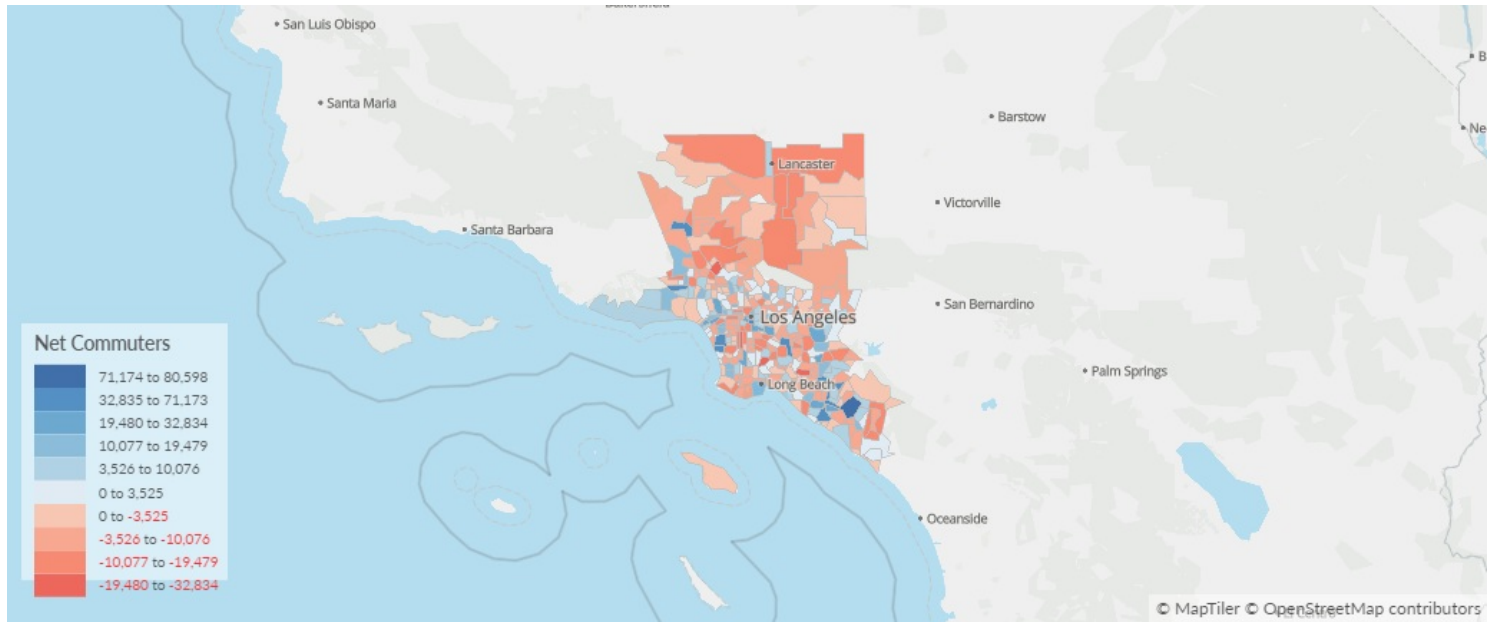

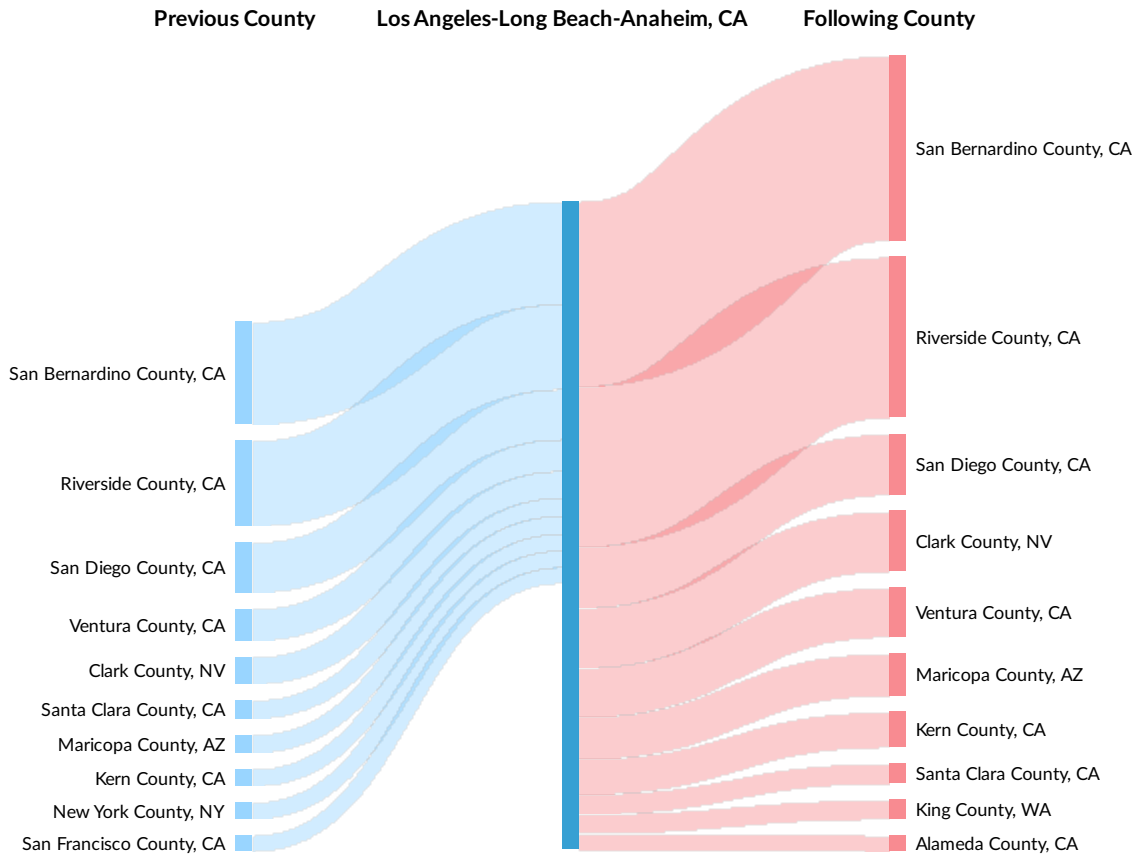

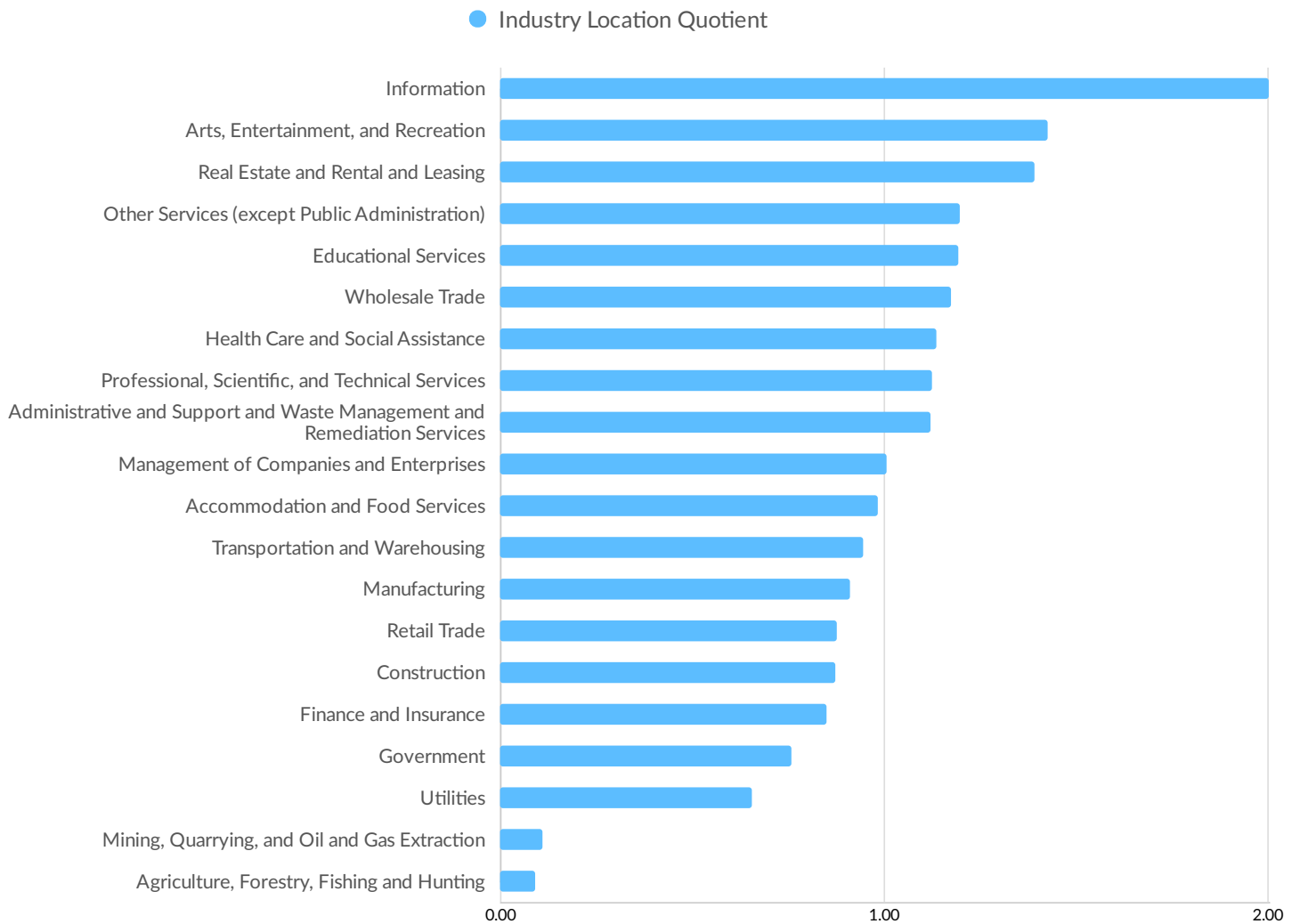

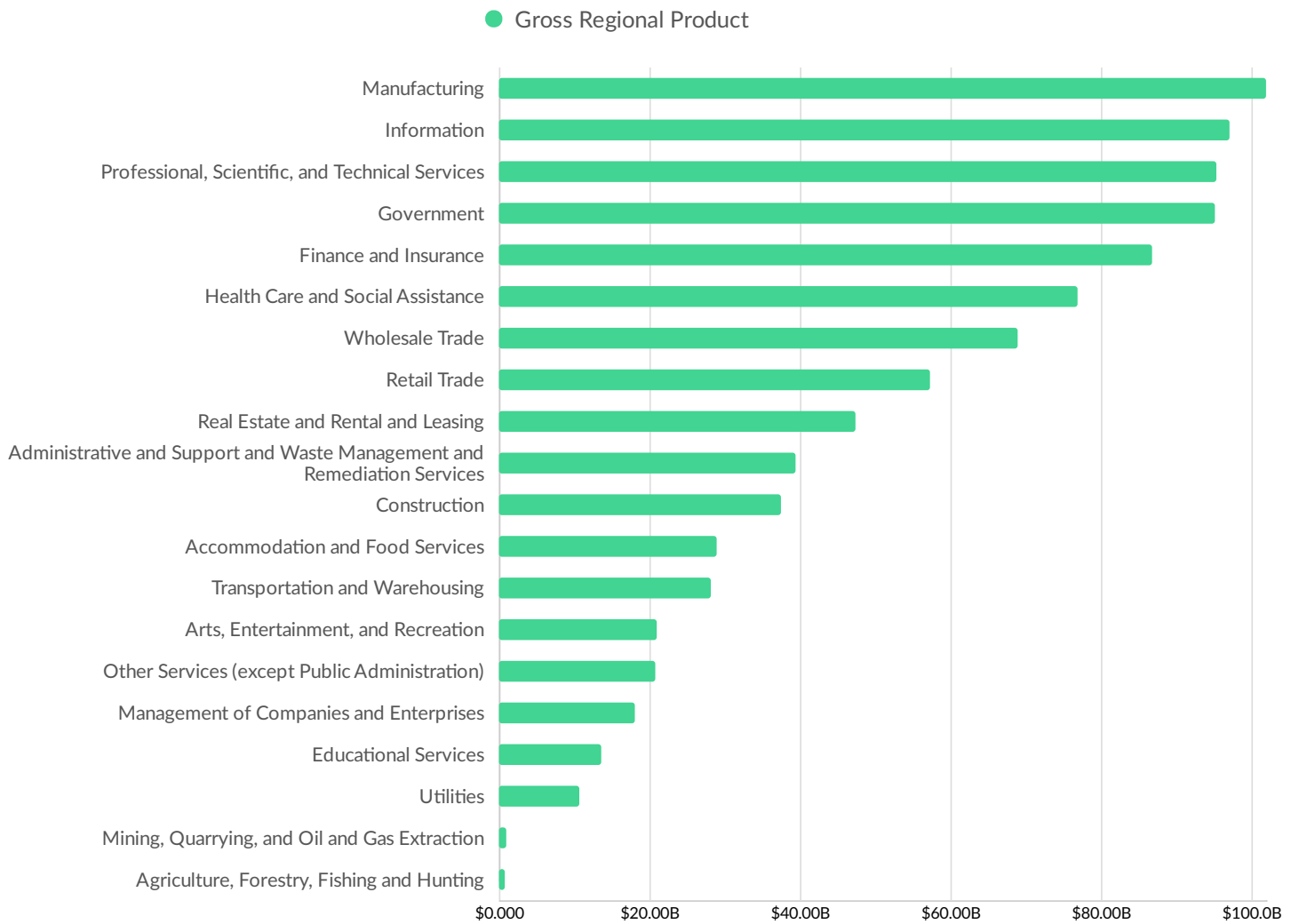

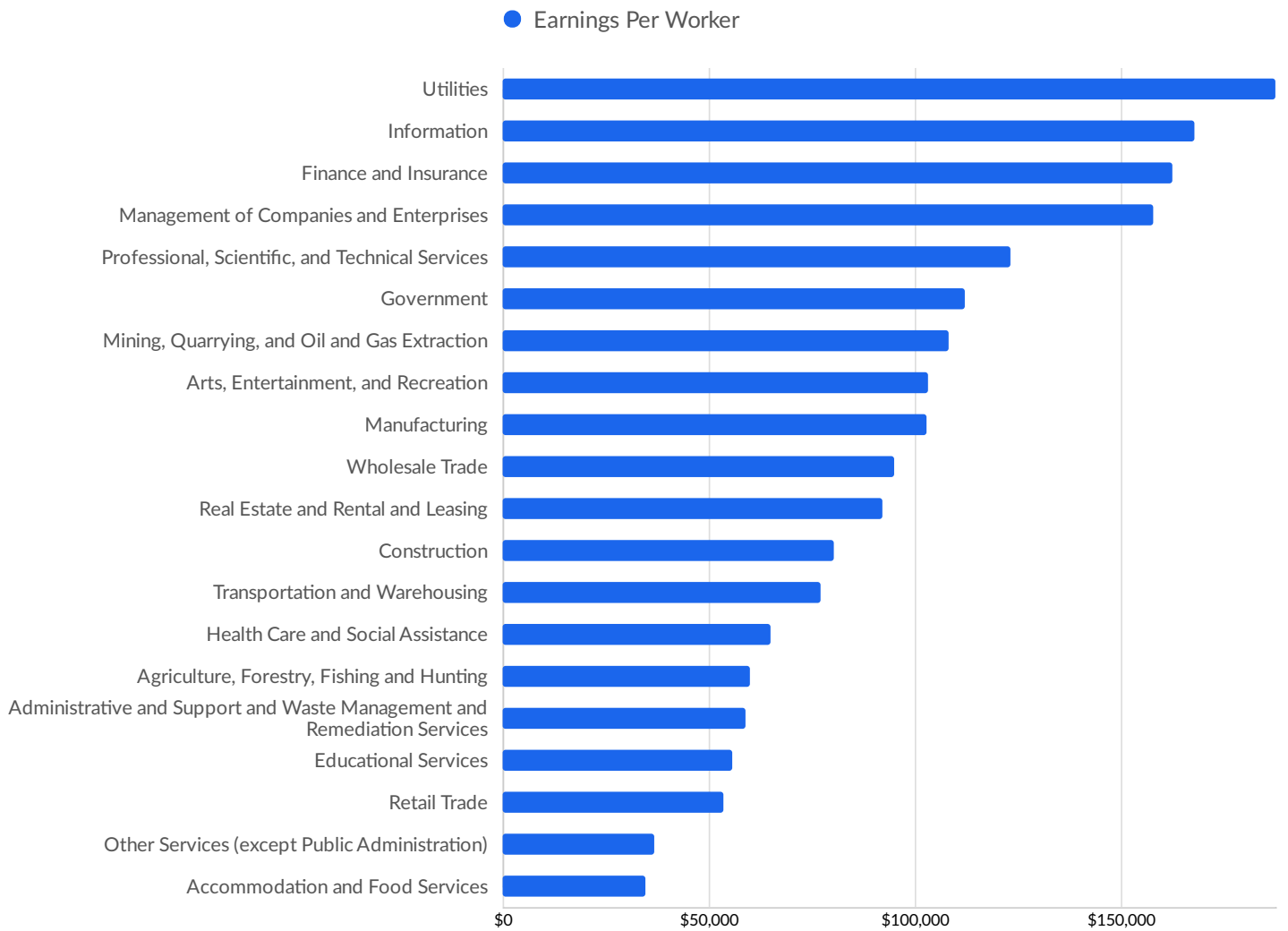
## Top Industry Location Quotient

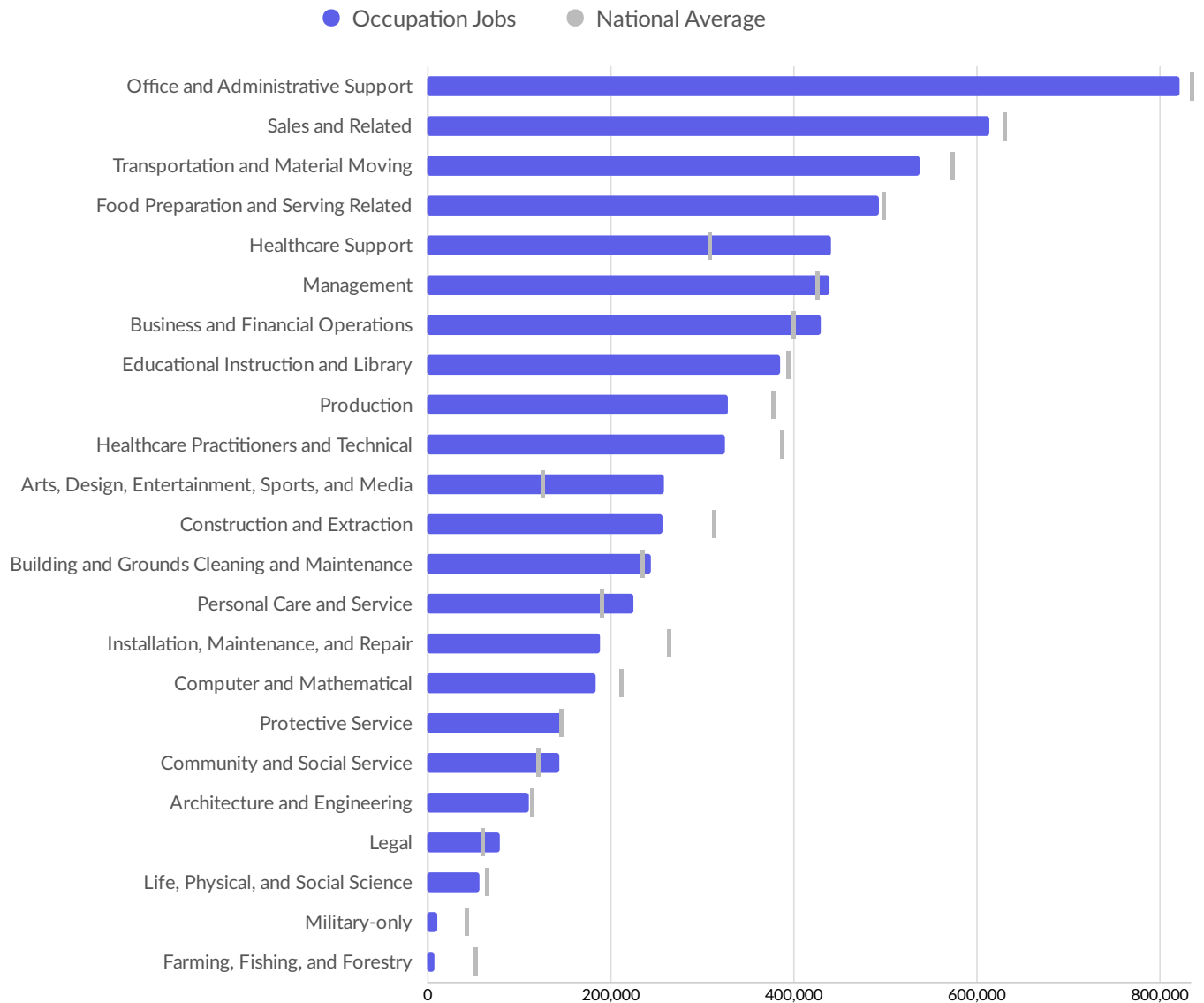

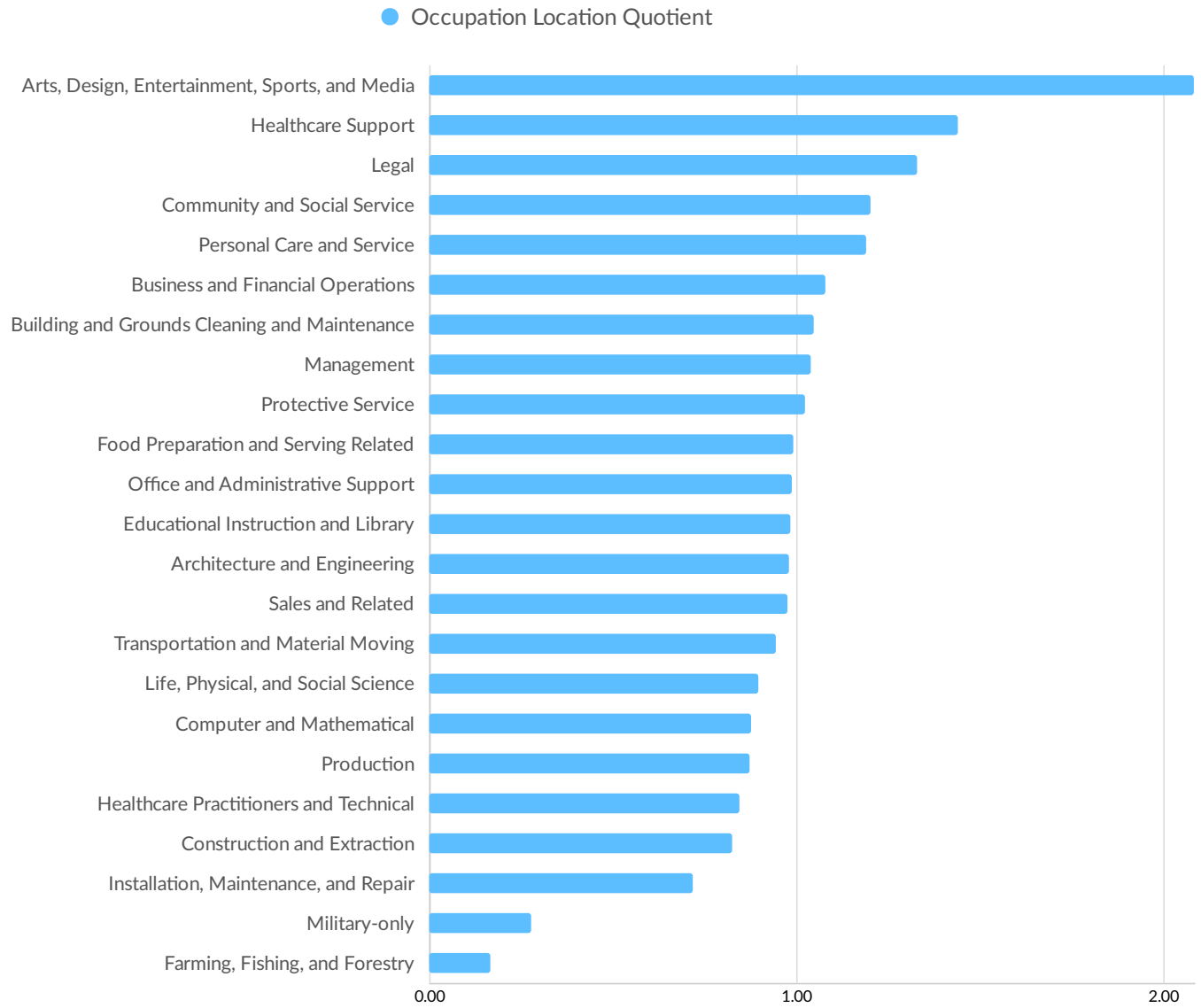
## Largest Occupations



## Top Growing Occupations



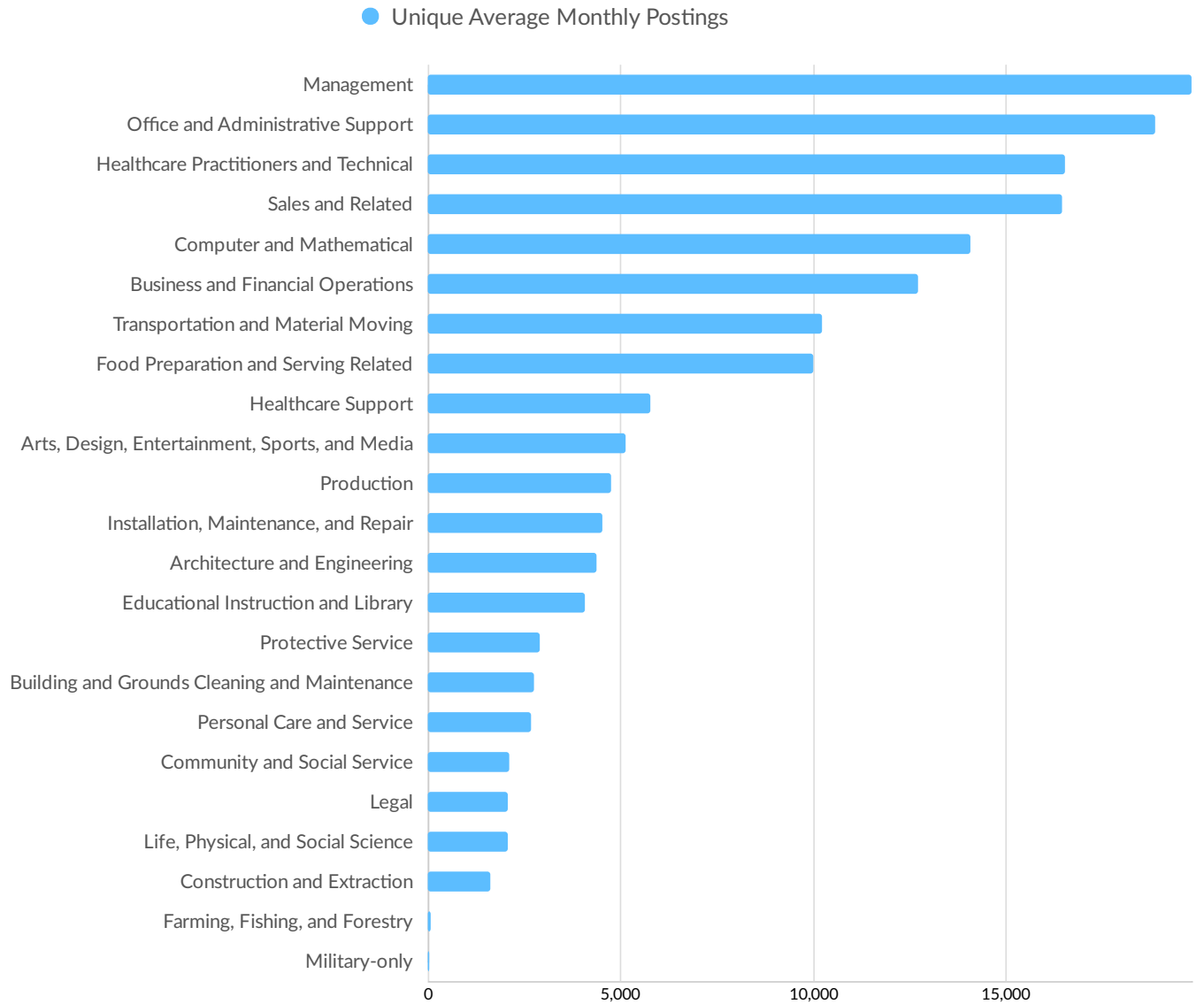
## Top Occupation Location Quotient



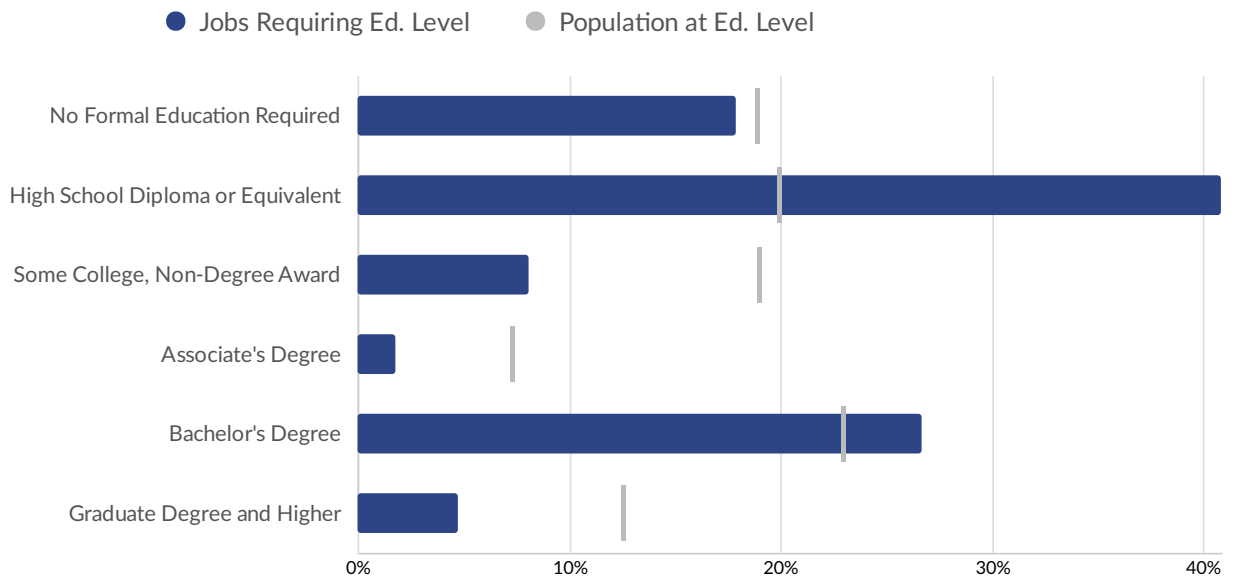

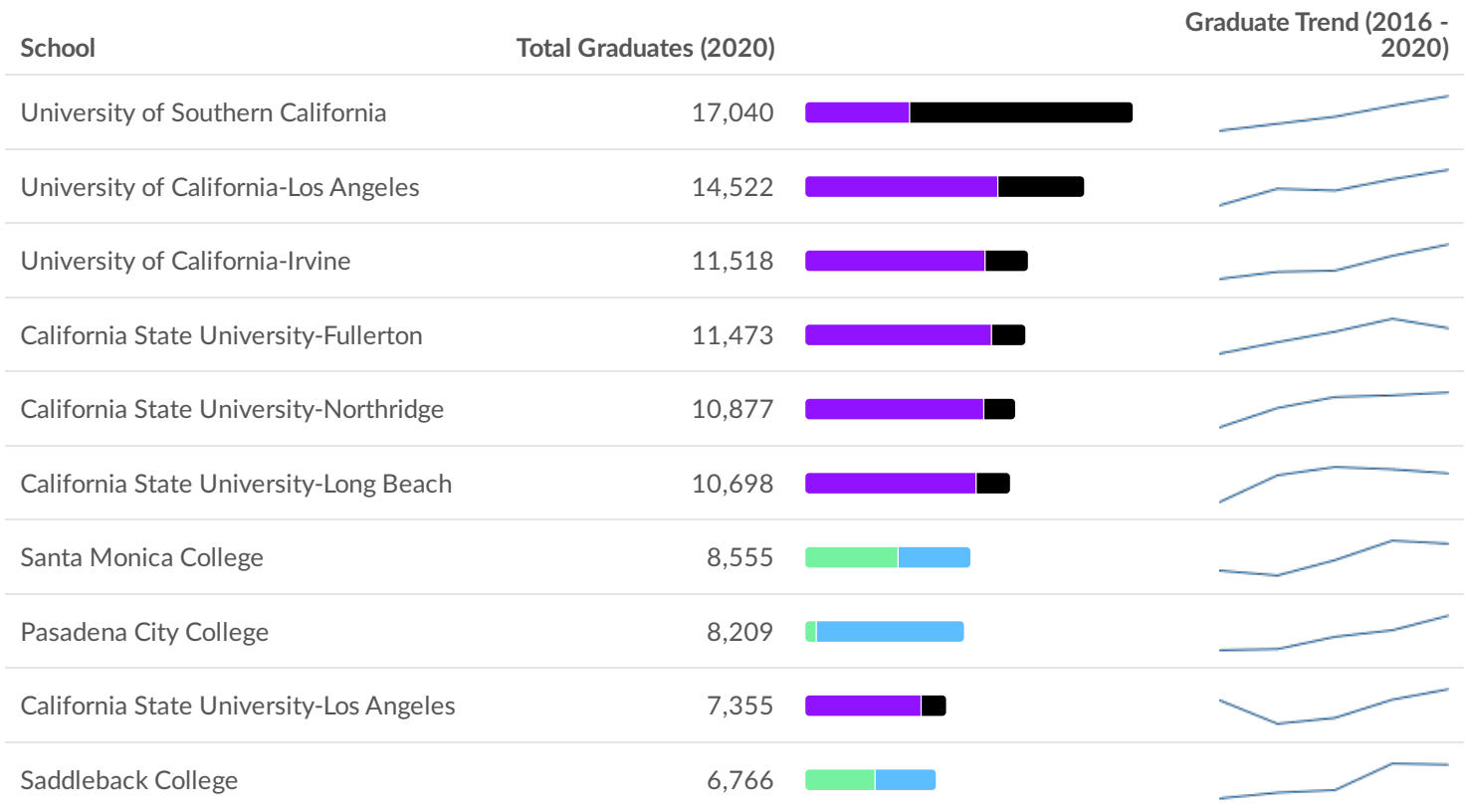
